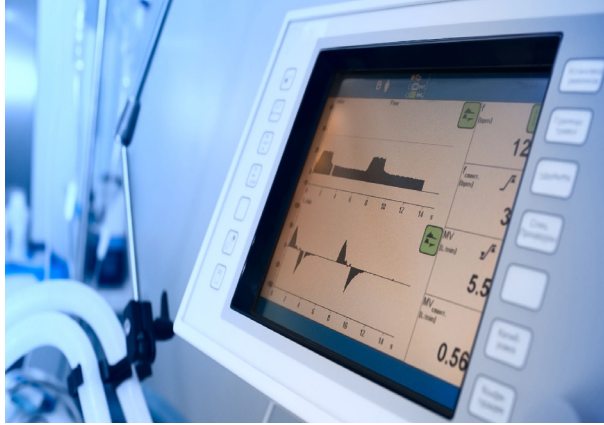

## PCAR Programme Overview

The TCAR course begins by focusing on concepts relevant to the care of the injured, hospitalised child:

- The trauma care spectrum
- The biomechanics of trauma
- The body's response to injury

Learners then apply these concepts by progressing through five interactive, case-based scenarios that focus on admission-to-discharge care of children with injuries to various body regions. Cases address the surgical, medical, and nursing management of patients with:

- Thoracic trauma
- Abdominal trauma
- Musculoskeletal trauma
- Head trauma
- Spine & spinal cord trauma
